## Executive summary

### Engagement Context:

The Sydney Harbour Federation Trust required an innovative tool that would allow the organisation to reach a broader community and more effectively gather community feedback. It was also necessary that the tool had to be able to conduct visitor satisfaction and feedback-based research on site. The Hello Lamp Post tool provided an engaging and interactive automated approach to intercept surveys, while also providing a COVID safe approach.

### Engagement approach:

Consultation was undertaken over a period of seven weeks, from 12 October to 30 November 2020. Hello North Head consisted of two main consultation tools. A customised Hello Lamp Post platform was set up for the site, enabling on site visitors to have interactions with key objects of cultural and historical significance. In turn, the tool gathered visitor input into the early stages of the Harbour Trust's refreshed approach to North Head Sanctuary. This was supported with a virtual online survey that asked questions on the future aspirations and vision of the community distributed to the broad community and key stakeholders of the Harbour Trust.



## Context for engagement

Engagement purpose/objectives:

- To understand community sentiment and aspirations amongst visitors to North Head, which consists of nearby residents, visitors and tourists, as well as providing the opportunity for all Australians to participate
- To understand how visitors are engaging and want to engage with North Head and its historical and cultural sites.
- To understand the various elements/features that are important to the community and what must be considered within future planning.

Engagement methodology:

The method of engagement was through exploratory qualitative research, to uncover new sentiment and opinions from a wider audience reaching both visitors to the site and engaged stakeholders through digital means. This was combined with a lesser element of confirmatory research undertaken by offering an indication of future plans for the site and eliciting feedback on these proposals. These research aims and objectives meant a mixture of qualitative and quantitative data was collected, through using a fixed online survey and via interactive text message conversations with animated objects located around North Head Sanctuary, to allow for more candid and unstructured feedback.

Aspiration questions

The following questions were included in both the online survey and within object conversations, with responses to these key insights a priority for the initial stage of this project. A detailed quantitative and qualitative analysis of this feedback is included in the appendix of this report.


1. How should we take a renewed focus on our Indigenous heritage and natural setting?
2. How can we further share our military history? What needs to happen to realise this?
3. The Art Deco building at the School of Artillery precinct could be reimagined, what would you like to see here?
4. What captures your imagination and interest at North Head Sanctuary?
5. What does the future of North Head Sanctuary look like to you?
6. What values will be important to consider in future planning?

Demographics

Demographic information was gathered during interactions with both the on-site object conversations and the online survey. Object conversations captured data from various age groups participating in the consultation process. This data was collected in an anonymous way, with anonymity a key feature of the object conversations, allowing trust to be built between the user and the objects, encouraging a more honest response. Generally, the interactive nature of an SMS conversation is more compelling to younger audiences, which as the survey results showed should be an area of focus for future consultation pieces.

## What is your age group?

630 out of 631 answered



As often observed with Hello Lamp Post, the engagement is frequently extended beyond the individual who is simply holding the phone. The below response is a testament to this:

### *Hello Cemetery*


*"We could plant more plants and make it better (Elijah, 5) Give some water to the trees to make it happier here (Jordan, 4) Provide more educational opportunities for this place to be a testimony to its history. (Manon, 25)"*

## Online Survey

To capture visitor profiling within the online survey, two questions were included which were salient to providing context for the accompanying vision questions. Owing to the significance of North Head as a First Nations site, it was important to give special consideration to the views of those with Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander heritage. If the user answered yes to this question, a follow up question was asked around how to take a renewed focus on the Indigenous heritage at North Head.

## Total survey completions survey and object conversations

The online survey received a high level of interaction with more than 1300 views and a completion rate of 62 per cent. 1000 individuals started the survey with just over 600 completing it in an average time of 8 minutes and 25 seconds. From this figure it is safe to assume that participants of the online survey took the necessary time to give the questions real thought and to provide useful feedback on the topic areas included in the consultation.



## Object conversations

The strong uptake of the onsite interactive engagement tool demonstrated that visitors to North Head are open and willing to explore innovative ways of communicating their opinions on the environment in which they are exploring or visiting. It was also able to uncover a variety of opinions and insights into early ideation and proposals on how to future proof the site.

## Interaction by week

The graph below shows interaction rates with objects, During the initial seven-week consultation period from 12 October to the 30 November 2020. During this time visitor numbers were impacted by COVID-19 restrictions with international and domestic tourism restricted. A hazard reduction burn took place onsite, closing the site for approximately five days. Given these factors, interaction levels are as expected and in comparison to other sites globally.

The object content for this initial phase of the project, was adapted away from the usual conversation mechanic, to prioritise the gathering of insights around the key visioning questions essential to


provide a foundation for the wider engagement. Also built into the system were a range of creative and playful questions, which would tee up the objects to talk about their history and ask engaging questions to visitors to enrich their experience when visiting North Head.

The content built into each object included a mixture of quantitative and qualitative questions within conversations with the audience. A full exhaustive list of these questions and responses is attached in an appendix to this report. It contains a rich mixture of sentiment, suggestions, ideas and opinions on the future of North Head.

## Engagement metrics

### Object popularity


Users were able to have a conversation of multiple messages with each of the objects across North Head as they journeyed around the site. The most popular were both the Parade and the Plotting Room with 87 and 82 conversations respectively. Other popular objects included the Lamp Post at the Parade Ground, the 3rd Quarantine Cemetery, the tunnel, the Visitor Centre and the Gun Emplacement. Less popular were the Bandicoot, the Monument and the Memorial, the engagement rates for these objects are understandable given these areas were closed during the second week of the project.



### Conversation insights (repeat conversations etc)

28 per cent of participants had two or more conversations with objects around the North Head site. This re-engagement figure is promising considering the dispersal of the objects upon North Head, and is likely due to custom farewell messages on each object, encouraging the audience to re-engage by challenging them to find other talking objects around the site.

## Engagement outcomes

### Themes and insights

#### Renewed focus on Indigenous heritage and natural setting

This question was posed to a smaller audience and was only asked to respondents who identified as Indigenous. The opinions gathered ranged from creative ideas to promote culture and history to a wider audience, to the use of Aboriginal techniques to maintaining flora and fauna. Whilst the audience pool was smaller, Indigenous heritage was a common theme within responses to other questions on the future of North Head and the reasons individuals and groups visit the site.

- *Be proud of our indigenous heritage - it makes Australia unique*
- *Equal opportunity for all and a renewed focus on indigenous health*
- *Indigenous Cultural walks & education (cultural & art classes)*
- *Indigenous landmarks, signs, artworks, and stories*
- *No need we are already over-emphasising elements that have never been that significant in indigenous culture anyway*
- *Outline importance of Local Country both past and present, use of local First Peoples eg guides, signage wording etc plus other stakeholders like Aboriginal Heritage Office*

#### Further sharing military history and realising this ambition

This question had a more specific focus on the military aspect of North Head's history and challenged the audience on how the further promotion of such history could be actioned. Common themes included; the expansion of tour availability on site, investment in the infrastructure around the military artefacts, bringing unheard stories to life, developing access for schools and increasing informational signage across the headland. A number of additional comments focused on the need for more immersive or interactive ways of addressing history which are appealing to a wider audience,

especially with the use of technology such as podcasts, mobile experiences and content available on social media.


- *Investment in the infrastructure, storytelling. And don't forget the women who served*
- *Turn the location into a school camp location and take students back in time to learn how it felt to be there during WWII. Give them a firsthand experience.*
- *I think there is too much war memorial, let's focus on harmony of nature instead of preserving buildings from a time of disharmony*
- *Offer self-guided audio tours from phone app*
- *Stories told by military personnel who worked and lived there ...virtual immersive 'tour' accessible online so anyone can access it. A before and after visit quiz that compares knowledge and feelings of and about the area.*
- *Better conservation/restoration and interp with RAAHC volunteers.*
- *A podcast that provides a guided tour of the site*
- *I am not really interested in military history. Natural environment much more important*

### School of Artillery precinct reimagination

This was an open-ended question, which was posed to the audience through the objects in and around the School of Artillery, inviting them to offer their suggestions on repurposing this historic area of North Head. The responses were varied, but mainly in line with the general feelings on careful planning and development which are sensitive to historical considerations. Some of the audience had well defined ideas, others were potential suggestions which may need to be given more thought.

- *A difficult one given the need to find uses compatible with heritage restoration & conservation. A small business innovation hub might be an option. Uses not requiring substantial night-time use important to wildlife conservation across headland.*
- *Maintain for public use as a meeting and education centre*
- *Cafe + art galleries*
- *Hmmm. Good question that would require more thought on my behalf. I think it needs to be used more. I think a mix of non-profit and commercial leasing could be a good idea. Ie like a few start-up businesses but also space for volunteers or non-profits to run workshops or do things like bird watching or have a bbg. Just basically use the space for the general public. Like cockatoo island.*
- *An education facility or art gallery with design workshops and a ballroom for wedding hire*
- *"Art Deco restoration could be a rest facility for school kids and families from the country ... and disadvantaged Adults. extension of Far West and Stewart House. Visitors could contribute by half day bush regen. The facility could be opened by Leonardo di Caprio ... 😊"*
- *An artist or writers retreat or wellness centre*
- *Keep original perhaps local artist could make feature walls*
- *No particular preference but having lived in Manly, visited NH many times ... I feel there are too many individual parts and a more coordinated vision, plan and approach would benefit. Perhaps a single visitor centre providing an overview of all the great items at NH, military history, quarantine station (appreciate that this is separate but very relevant with Covid 19 and out quarantine hotels / 14-day isolation), cemetery, fallen soldier's memorial, military, etc. Perhaps outdoor facilities including amenities, BBQ etc, more interesting walks - separate to the road (similar to new path on bluefish drive) ... more distributed parking / amenities, tasteful retail that activates precinct.*

## Capturing imagination and interest at North Head Sanctuary




This graph reflects data from both across both the online survey and within object conversations, and when asked what captured their imagination at North Head, the responses could be categorised into core themes above. Mentions of each topic gives a clear indication of reasons why the audience is interested in visiting North Head, with the site's scenic views being the dominant factor. This is followed closely by the history, the bushland and the beauty of the area as a walking destination, with a rich biodiversity to explore by the ocean.

### Notable Responses

- *The solitude of walking up there several times a week*
- *The unique Australian fauna (e.g, echidna, bandicoot) and fauna to be found in this wonderful landscape.*
- *It was to see an untouched piece of Sydney, pristine and full of native plants and fauna*
- *The Military history and the memorials there, the natural environment and the public land that is for all of us to enjoy.*
- *Peaceful natural environment near to city for public to enjoy through bushwalks and education/interpretation of flora, fauna, aboriginal history, and military history*
- *The history of the quarantine station, the fort, the aboriginal settlement and of course the fabulous views*
- *The history of the fortress. Its role as the site of the beloved-to-all-Gunners School of Artillery*
- *The walking trails and views. It's what makes me as a local resident keep coming back.*
- *The historical significance. I was also a soldier who trained at the School of Artillery at the time of the Vietnam war*
- *Untouched nature, the views, Shelly and Collins Beaches, the Cabbage Tree Bay marine reserve, bandicoots and echidnas... walking and running around North Head trails, Sunsets from the lookouts.*

## The future of North Head Sanctuary




This chart depicts a breakdown of participants' ideas (mentions) of what the future of North Head Sanctuary looks like. Ensuring its openness and accessibility alongside maintaining walking routes were the largest portion. It is particularly interesting to note that more than 12 percent of users when asked this question, stated that North Head should not change at all, implying their satisfaction with current management. Preservation of existing buildings, their history and the natural bushland also featured highly, with many specific comments on the management of bushland in the wake of the fires. History, specifically military, and the preservation of Indigenous culture represented small slices of public sentiment.

- Increasing access but, paradoxically, ensuring the survival of these flora and fauna.
- A natural environment for the enjoyment of all, free from commercial interests and for future generations of enjoyment
- Accessible, interactive and informative but still with ability to park easily, stroll and admire the views
- Combining sense of bushland and views and indigenous history, with recent heritage and war memorial, and (if possible) appropriate utilisation of the build space. So sad to see derelict buildings unused - no point being empty
- Hopefully a place that will be preserved and cherished for future generations
- At the moment devastated by out of control unnecessary burnt
- Removal all commercial activities and improved environmental management, stop the fires
- Preservation and restoration, environmentally responsible, practical and sensitive use of existing buildings to ensure they are protected, restored and maintained into the future
- A place for the whole community to enjoy, hiking trails, biking, wellness, educational, arts precinct - studios/workshops/exhibitions, community markets, community concerts
- Opening up of WW2 tunnels, picnic area, artillery school with museum, increased parking, upgrade walking tracks

Values to consider in future planning

## What values will be important to consider in future planning?



Another very open-ended question, eliciting the key values from the audience to which apply when making decisions on the future of North Head. The top 10 are summarised in the chart, with accessibility, environment and preservation standout values which appeared within multiple conversations and were the most mentioned. Future planning could be seen as fairly ambiguous, and this was evident in the wide range of ideas, suggestions and considerations offered by the audience. Some of the more notable and forward thinking are listed below.

- *Protected, Inclusive, Vibrant, Natural, Historic, Authentic, Resilient, Adventurous, Forward-thinking*
- *A politician-free zone*
- *Environmentalism, openness for the public*
- *Don't over commercialise it. One of the values is its simplicity when you visit.*
- *Limited development. Recognition of less is more in terms of allowing nature to take centre stage*
- *To preserve the history and prevent overdevelopment*
- *People first. Transparent accountability of spending of public money.*
- *Respect for the native bushland, cultural and military history.*
- *Sanctuary for flora and fauna. Disability access and stroller access.*
- *Preservation and accurate recording of the history.*
- *The history. The need to make it a destination and financial viability.*
- *Protection and conservation - remaining in public hands*
- *Keep it natural and don't involve politicians in decision-making*

## Commons themes within Conversations

The visualisation below shows the density of certain topics and themes within the engagement, and to how frequently they appeared within conversations.



A place to understand and appreciate the story of the Gayamagal people, and engage with nature, Country and culture.

- Another common theme was to provide accurate information which preserves the integrity of what happened at North Head, at the hands of its various occupants from both European and aboriginal perspectives. It is clear a balance of historical past is a priority, and to make this accessible to all audiences to experience and learn from.
- Notable Responses
  - *Please include Gayamagal names alongside (not replacing) the European names for the different locations at North Head.*
  - *Historical information about the Gayamagal people connection to the land in the area, including sculptures and educational sites*
  - *No more developments such as the Q Station which excludes the public. MUCH more focus on pre-European life. Sustainable use.*
  - *Mix of (and disparity of) Indigenous and European history*
  - *A balance of European and Aboriginal perspectives on the area, since only then can we both live in peace*

### **Preserving and interpreting our nation's military history for future generations**

North Head Sanctuary presents a rare opportunity to enhance the visitor experience, to discover and learn about its strategic role in our country's military history during World War II. It is also an important site for remembering those who served in the Australian Defence Force during past conflicts.

- It became apparent on reviewing object conversations that the audience who participated were already very knowledgeable about the area's significant history. Also included were a number of suggestions on how it could be better presented or maintained for future generations. There is a demonstrably appetite for richer and more accessible ways of sharing this information to ensure it is not lost as the site moves into a new future.
- It was also good to see a number of responses from either serving ex forces personnel, who were as expected strong advocates for the preservation of military assets at North Head.
- Notable Responses
  - *Recognition and promotion of the important military history of the site*
  - *I just want the military history and people's service remembered and preserved.*
  - *I appreciate the care that has been taken to try and keep the area usable for the community; the information on the military sites and military walks - sandstone photo illustrations are outstanding.*
  - *Recognition of the traditional custodians and the local flora and fauna is important however most visitors are primarily interested in the military history of the site and its role during WW2. This should be the primary focus.*
  - *As a former serving military officer, it is disappointing to see the slow eraser of the contemporary history and former uses of the North Head Sanctuary. SHFT has completely failed to understand how the area was used by the military over time. Much of the infrastructure can be re interpreted and used for modern uses while at the same time preserving the natural environment of the area. So far there has been little or no interpretation of the stone walls that criss cross North Head, including through the SHFT land tenure. These walls were built with particular expertise and are engineering wonders, straight and built to last the test of time. The social context they were built in should be researched and explored and then interpreted as a vital*

*part of the infrastructure. It is pleasing to see the tunnels are to be refurbished and opened for visitors.*

## **North Head Sanctuary: a new public purpose and life**

Finding innovative approaches to repurposing existing spaces, buildings and facilities in order to create memorable experiences.

- The common theme within conversation was around ensuring development of buildings and structures at North head are consistent with the sites cultural heritage, and any additions should be carefully considered and the options presented to the audience who will inevitably benefit or not from the change.
- Some responses spoke to more radical opinions of repurposing or converting buildings to have more contemporary uses for events, commercial activities and tourism activity.
- There is a clear consensus commercial use of North Head should be severely restricted especially amongst new development and stakeholders.
  
- Notable Responses
  - *It is imperative that North Head Sanctuary remain a sanctuary for the animals and plants that reside there. That being said there are so many buildings and spaces that have fallen into disuse and can be creatively revived to enhance the experience of both locals and tourists when visiting North Head.*
  - *Please find a suitable use for the old barracks buildings which are such a wonderful asset but which at present are totally unused and wasted.*
  - *Many in the Manly community feel that the army barracks are being underutilised - buildings are degrading and the community is not able to utilise it. This is despite Manly Village public school bursting at the seams and a lack of sporting facilities being provided at the school. As a taxpayer, I think this is wrong.*
  - *I have no problem with refurbishing buildings and letting them to help fund the maintenance of the whole area.*
  - *Remove old military buildings and concrete structures that were built around the time of WW2. They are ugly and do not add any value to the site. Understand there may be some need to recognise use but house this in a smaller area centrally and remove old barracks, concrete roads etc. that are so spread out and return land to its original state.*

## Visitor satisfaction and experience

A number of visitor satisfaction and experience questions were included within object conversations to identify any potential improvements to the visitor experience on North Head. Visitor experience improvements included expanding walking routes throughout the Headland, and a focus on increasing available information on local wildlife and culture. Users were candid and honest in their feedback on their visitor experience when visiting and where they saw potential improvements and opportunities, reflecting the anonymity of the feedback tool.

- *There is so much potential for increasing visitor numbers and awareness of the site*
- *Be aware as you improve access/facilities visitor pressure on the environment increases. Therefore, good design is paramount*
- *It is good to have interpretive signage readily available whether or not visitor centres are open.*

- *North Head Sanctuary has not had any real improvements for all tourists and all locals visiting. It NEEDS TO BE UPDATED!!! It needs more ESSENTIAL BASIC services to provide a good experience when visiting there - which is lacking now!!*
- *I hope that lack of money and vision does not compromise the core values of the site.*

## Enhanced Communications

The tool provided the Harbour Trust with a new communications tool to reach and engage with visitors, and share historical information and visitor tips. This was done passively through friendly conversations. This is a core part of the Hello Lamp Post System which allows for the audience to use 'self-exploration' to engage with artefacts and objects which interest them personally.

- *Have you been in the tunnels and heard the gurgling of running water?*
  - This flow of water was not anticipated in the construction of this tunnel network, forcing the engineers to drastically alter the drainage plans.
    - **38 times**
- *What do you think is underneath here?*
  - It's designed to look inconspicuous! Concealed eight metres underground is The Plotting Room, which relayed coordinates for the artillery guns.
    - **35 times**
- *Something special used to happen for Manly in the Barracks building, can you guess what?*
  - During the War, the upper storey of the Barracks building featured a grand Ballroom for entertaining, where soldiers hosted local dances for the community of Manly!
    - **22 times**
- Look out to sea - what's the furthest thing you can see in the distance?
  - *The enormous guns that were here had a firing range of over 28km! They could fire two rounds per minute and would be targeting ships out at sea.*
    - **18 times**
